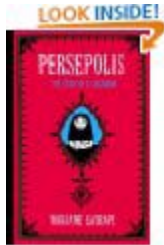


Suggested Memoirs for 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter (Honors) / 1<sup>st</sup> Semester (Non-Honors)
